



How to Place a Stop Payment on a Check or Series of Checks

If you need to place a stop payment on a check or series of checks, you can do so through online banking or our mobile banking app.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS OPTION DOES NOT APPLY TO DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS, ACH WITHDRAWALS, PAPER CHECKS ISSUED VIA BILL PAY, OR CHECK BY PHONE PAYMENTS. THIS OPTION IS FOR PAPER CHECKS WRITTEN OFF A CHECKING OR MONEY MARKET ACCOUNT.

- 1. Login into online banking or mobile banking.
- 2. Click or tap on the 3 dot menu option
 - a. In online banking, it is at the top left side of the screen

b. In the mobile banking app, it is at the bottom left side of the screen



3. Click or tap on Stop Payment





4. The Stop Payment Screen will appear, providing the option to place a stop payment on a single check or a range of check numbers.

- 5. Select the appropriate option and provide either the single check number or the range of check numbers for which the stop payment needs to be placed.
- 6. Select the account from which the fee is to be paid.
- 7. Click or Tap "Continue"

8. The Verify Stop Payment Request screen will appear. If all details looks correct, click or tap "Confirm". If changed are needed, click or tap "Edit". If there is no longer a need for the Stop Payment Request, click or tap "Cancel".
